Interesting Facts for the Week

Hajimi Fuji, a Japanese pilot in WWII, volunteered for the kamikaze but was refused acceptance because he had a wife and two young children. To honor his wish Fukuro, his wife, drowned her two young girls and drowned herself. Fukuro initially opposed her husband's joining the special attack force, but in time she came to understand her husband's firm determination to join his students to attack the enemy. On December 14, 1944, she left the house with her two young daughters, went to Arakawa River near Kumagaya Aviation School where her husband was an instructor, and jumped into the frigid water with her daughters. Hajimi then flew as a kamikaze pilot, meeting his death on May 28, 1945. The surrender of Imperial Japan was announced on August 15 and formally signed on September 2, 1945, bringing the hostilities of World War II to a close.
